

Utah DECA Conference Attire State Competition

MEMBERS AND ADVISORS

The following dress code has been developed for the Utah DECA State Competition and reflects the National DECA Standards.

Students not in the correct attire for the competitions could receive a deduction in points. DECA Board Members will decide if points should be deducted for inappropriate dress.

Students not in Professional Attire during the Awards Sessions will not be allowed on stage.

PROFESSIONAL ATTIRE

- Men: Dress slacks, dress shirt, dress shoes and socks, sweater and/or sport coat. (Tie is recommended.) A dress suit or DECA blazer is also appropriate, but not required.
- Women: Dress slacks, dress, coordinated shirt/blouse, dress shoes, skirt. Dresses and skirts must hit at or below the knee. A dress suit or a DECA blazer is also appropriate.

CASUAL ATTIRE

Men: Slacks, cords, khaki, button-down shirts, polos, t-shirts, etc.

Women: Khakis, cords, skirts, capris, sports shirts, collared shirts/button-down, t-shirts, sweaters, etc.

*Hats, shorts, and tank tops are inappropriate the entire conference *

Conference Activities:		Appropriate Dress
1.	Travel to/from conference	Appropriate clothing for travel
2.	All general sessions, competitions, and activities	Professional attire (See above)
3.	Competitive events	Professional attire
4.	Non-conference activities such as shopping, sightseeing, dinner, etc.	Casual attire
